Chugach Electric Association, Inc. (Chugach) is re-building two 11-mile sections of the Quartz Creek 115kV Transmission line which connects generation resources on the Kenai Peninsula with Anchorage and the Rail Belt utilities. Additionally, Chugach may likely be assigned project responsibility for the rebuilding of a 50-mile section of 115kV transmission line connecting with the Quartz Creek line. Chugach seeks a Project Engineer, proficient in the delivery of electric utility projects, for secondment. Specifically, the successful project engineer candidate will have experience with the successful delivery of multiple transmission projects.

It is expected the Utility Project Engineer who will relocate to Anchorage Alaska for a period of 9 – 12 months. This position will be physically sited at the Chugach North Campus.
