Each responding Contractor must prepare a Letter of Intent by Tuesday, January 5, 2023, after which an individual, secure folder using Citrix ShareFile will be created specifically for this purpose. The Letters of Intent may be submitted to Dustin Highers, VP Corporate Programs, at dustin_highers@chugachelectric.com.

A pre-proposal meeting will be held at Wednesday, January 18, 2023 at 10:00 AM AKST, via Microsoft Teams web conference. A meeting invitation will be sent to interested Proposers who have submitted their Letter of Intent.

Statements of Qualification for each chosen program are due, uploaded at Chugach's Citrix ShareFile file sharing service, no later than 4:00 PM Alaska Time, Monday, February 6, 2023. Cost Proposals should be submitted at the same time but in a separate file.

Questions may be asked in writing at any time, and they will be answered in writing usually within two working days leading up to the final submittal date. All questions and answers will be issued to all registered Contractors through their assigned ShareFile folder. Questions shall be submitted electronically to Dustin Highers, VP Corporate Programs, at dustin_highers@chugachelectric.com with the subject line "RFQ 22-20 Questions".

Proposers shall specify in their response to this RFQ in writing whether exceptions are taken to any of the terms and conditions of the attached Professional Services Contract. Exceptions may result in Proposal rejection.

Proposals are to be valid for sixty (60) days from the Proposal due date.
