Chugach prefers a full-service Proposal but will consider Proposals for segments of the work only if a full-service Proposal is not submitted and accepted. Interested Proposers must either be able to perform the identified services directly or with the aid of subcontractors. All subcontractors are to be fully identified in the response to the RFP.

Proposers will be evaluated based upon the elements outlined in Section 13. Cost of Services provided will be compared to each response.
